Detective Sergeant Neil Barker

Sgt. Barker was a police officer with the Winnipeg, Manitoba Police Department for over 20 years. During his career, he served as a beat constable, detective and homicide investigator. Later in his career, he served as the major crimes coordinator. He is also an academy instructor. He is currently assigned to the Canadian Police College. Sgt. Barker holds a Masters degree in criminal justice.

This course focuses on the eight most credible criteria for determining a person's truthfulness in an interview/interrogation setting. Additionally, the course will cover twenty other factors, which can help determine if a person is being deceptive. These indicators have been learned and studied over the course of Sgt. Barker's career and are all validated. Day #2 will focus on obtaining a written statement and statement analysis to determine the person's veracity. If you have not attended Sgt.
