

The City of Beachwood has an open position for Full-Time Fire Inspector in the Department of Fire and Rescue. This position reports directly to the Fire Chief. Starting salary range is \$55,228.33-\$62,354.59. The following minimum requirements must be met to be considered for the position:

High School diploma (or GED equivalent); successful completion of the State of Ohio Fire Safety Inspector course; successful completion of the Ohio Fire Academy's (or equivalent) Arson Investigation 1 and 2 (within 1 year of being appointed); considerable knowledge of the principles, practices and procedures of firefighting and fire prevention

The following knowledge, abilities and skills will also be considered during the interview process:

- Shall have considerable knowledge in building construction
- Ability to apply codes and ordinances to plans
- Shall possess good communication skills, both orally and in writing. Shall have the ability to plan and present speeches and demonstrations on fire prevention
- Shall have strong computer, time management and organizational skills
- Ability to climb ladders and stairs, crawl into confined spaces; occasionally lift and/or move in excess of 50 pounds, turn valve wheels, or push heavy doors in order to gain access to and inspect all parts of the premises
- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently exposed to outdoor weather conditions. The employee occasionally works near moving mechanical parts; in high, precarious places, and is occasionally exposed to wet, humid conditions.
